Th	12-Jan-12	<b>SIEM REAP (B, L, D)</b> We'll start after breakfast at about 10:00 a.m., giving you time to sleep in after a long flight. We'll drive about 13 km from Siem Reap to one of the first major capitals of the Khmer Empire in the late 9th century. Here, you will visit the Rolous group of temples including Preah Ko, Kong and Lolei. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, we'll visit the Angkor National Museum and Artisans d'Angkor (wood and stone carving) and the Old Market. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at Borei Angkor Resort & Spa in Siem Reap.		Borei Angkor Hotel
Fr	13-Jan-12	<b>SIEM REAP (B, L, D)</b> After breakfast at the hotel we'll visit the lost city of the Khmer Empire, entering through the South Gate of Angkor Thom, with giant faces of the famous Bayon and Baphoun Temples, Elephant and Leper King Terraces, and the unforgettable jungle temple of Ta Prohm. Lunch will be served at local restaurant. Then back to our hotel for a short rest. At around 15:30, we'll visit the World Heritage Angkor Wat Temple. We'll study both the splendid architecture and the amazing bas-reliefs until sunset. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at Borei Angkor Resort & Spa in Siem Reap.	Siem Reap	Borei Angkor Hotel
Sa	14-Jan-12	<b>SIEM REAP (B, L, D)</b> After breakfast at hotel we'll visit the petite pink-stone Banteay Srey Temple, referred to as the jewel of Khmer art. On our return to Siem Reap we'll stop at Banteay Samre Temple and then visit the local village of Pradak to see local natural palm sugar production. Lunch will be served at local restaurant. After lunch we'll visit other fabulous temples: Preah Khan, Neak Pean, East Mebon Temples, Sras Srang and Pre Rup temple where we'll enjoy the view of the countryside during sunset. Su	15-Jan-12	<b>SIEM REAP - PREAK TOAL BIRD SANCTUARY - BATTAMBANG (B, L, D)/ Charter boat</b> After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Chong Khneas for charter boat (wooden boat with bench seats and a small deck on the back) to Battambang via Tonle Sap Great Lake, one of the world's most productive bodies of fresh water. On the way, we'll visit floating fishing villages and observe fishing techniques of local people and stop at the small floating house of the Environment & Wild Life Protection office in Prek Toal then continue by small boat to see the bird sanctuary. A box lunch will be served on boat. Then continue to Battambang. Check-in at hotel upon arrival. Dinner will be served at local restaurant. Mo	16-Jan-12	<b>BATTAMBANG (B)</b> After breakfast at our hotel, we'll visit the Village of Kaun Khlong, where the Cambodian Village Fund is building a classroom building at the local primary school. We'll visit the school and celebrate with the children, teachers and local officials. We'll meet the Reach-for-the-Sky girls that the Cambodian Village Fund is helping to keep in school. Tu	17-Jan-12	<b>BATTAMBANG (B)</b> After breakfast at our hotel, we'll tour Battambang and the surrounding area. Sitting on the Sangker River just south west of the Tonle Sap Lake, Battambang town is at the heart of Cambodia's 'rice bowl', and even though it is the country's second biggest town, it still has a very local, un-touristed, provincial atmosphere. The nearby countryside also harbors old pagodas, Angkorian era ruins, caves, waterfalls, and even Khmer Rouge period killing fields. Overnight at Bambu Battambang Hotel in Battambang. We	18-Jan-12	<b>BATTAMBANG - PHNOM PENH (B, L, D)/ Private bus</b> After breakfast at our hotel, we'll transfer by private bus to Phnom Penh, Cambodia's capital city. On the way we'll stop to see traditional silver carving at Kampong Luong and the famous pottery art at Kampong Chhnang. Lunch at local restaurant in Kampong Chhnang. Check-in at our hotel upon arrival in Phnom Penh. Time to relax until late afternoon, when we'll take Cyclos from our hotel, along the river, to visit Wat Phnom. Dinner at local restaurant. Th	19-Jan-12	<b>PHNOM PENH (B, L, D)</b> Breakfast at hotel. We'll continue our tour of Phnom Penh to visit Independence Monument, Royal Palace with Silver Pagoda and National Museum. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit Toul Sleng Genocide Museum and Toul Tumpung Market (Russian Market). Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at Naga World Hotel in Phnom Penh. Fr	20-Jan-12	<b>PHNOM PENH (B, L, D)</b> Breakfast at hotel then visit Koh Dach (an island in the Mekong River) and Prek Bankong. Upon arriving at the island, we'll visit a green tropical plantation and local weaving village where people use traditional wooden looms to weave silk. We'll also visit a local monastery. Upon our return to Phnom Penh we'll begin a sunset cruise on Chaktomouk River (Four Face Rivers) with a wonderful buffet dinner (including Angkor Beer, soft drink and drinking water) and music. 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Sa	21-Jan-12	<b>PHNOM PENH - INCHON - LAX (B, L, D)</b> After breakfast at hotel, we'll take a half-day cooking class in the morning (09.00 - 13.00), including a market tour. Markets in Cambodia are most interesting in the morning when fresh produce arrives and most Cambodians do their shopping. The half-day class will give you time to prepare two dishes from scratch. Lunch will be the dishes we prepare. Check-out of hotel and visit the Killing Field of Choeung Ek, the Central Market (Phsar Thmey) for souvenir shopping then dinner at local restaurant before transfer to airport for night departure.
